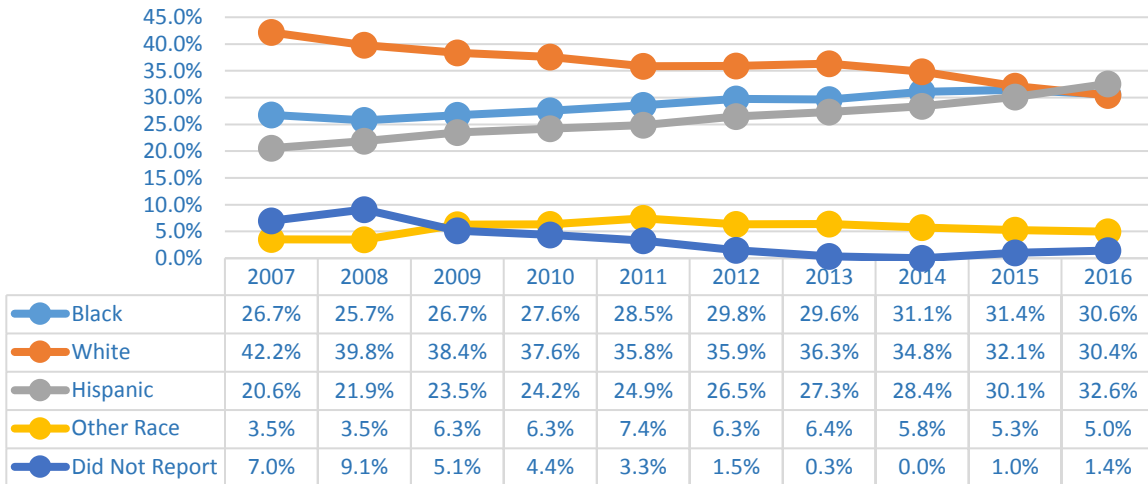
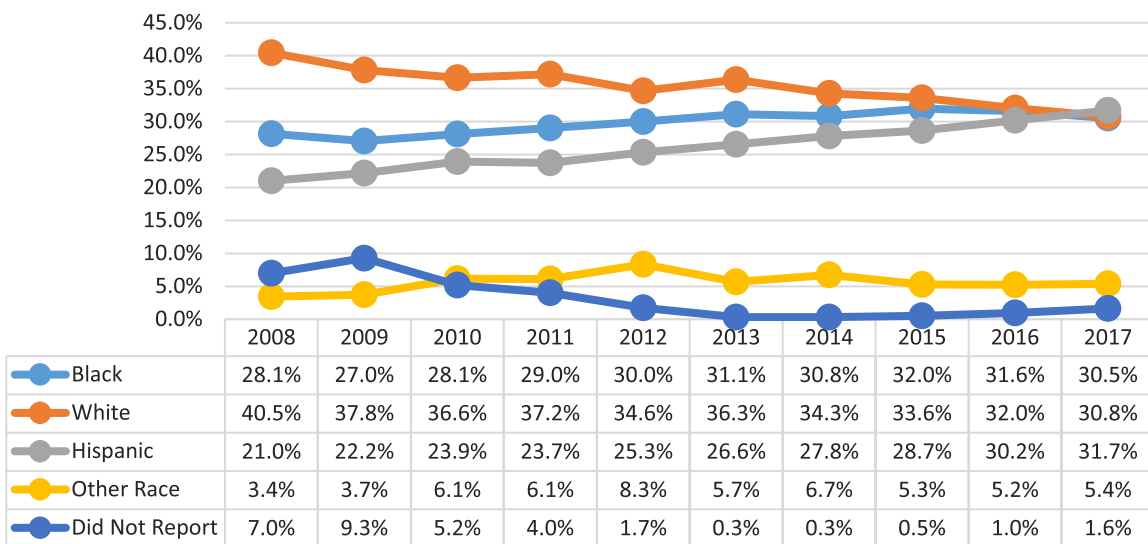


## FAST FACTS – Trends in Student Race/Ethnicity

Housatonic Community College is a minority-majority college in the State of Connecticut. In the past ten years the percentage trends of the College has been that white students are declining as Hispanic and Black students as a percentage of enrollment are increasing. Hispanic students have increased such that HCC is now eligible for Title III grant funding.

Note: In the tables and on the graph above, "Other" is the count of students who reported themselves as Asian, American Indian or Alaskan Native, Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander, more than one race or any other race.
