

NetID Username Change

The Specifics

On April 13th (after 5:30 p.m.) and from that point thereafter, you will be required to use a new network username (NetID) to log on to our campus computer systems.

This new **NetID** will utilize your existing BannerID. (For those of you, who do not know your BannerID, please see "What's My BannerID" note below.)

This change is the essential first step required for implementing the Luminis portal, one feature of the portal is a single sign on for many college services including BANNER WEB, web email -- Outlook Web Access (OWA) and WebCT Vista!
We ask for your cooperation during this important transition.

Example

If you are a current staff or faculty member, your **New** NetID will be composed of the following two items:

- Username: **BannerID**
- Domain: **@CollegeDomain**

So if your NetID is:

JTimey@ccc.commnet.edu (or) **JDoe@ncc.commnet.edu**

Then your **New** Faculty or Staff NetID will be:

01234567@ccc.commnet.edu (or) **98765432@ncc.commnet.edu**

Please note your Email address remains unchanged.

Student accounts are not affected!

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What's My Banner ID?

To assist you in this transition an email will be sent to you in the beginning of April containing your BannerID. You should also hear from your college's IT Department on how to get your BannerID locally.

Some Answers to Several Common Questions Regarding NetID Changes

Q. Currently I use my first initial – last name to log on to my office computer jtimey@ccc.comnet.edu; how will I logon now?

A. You will use BannerID@ccc.commmnet.edu which will look like this:



Q. It looks like there is a difference between the username for NetID and the username for Banner Web for Faculty even though they both have my BANNER ID in them – correct?

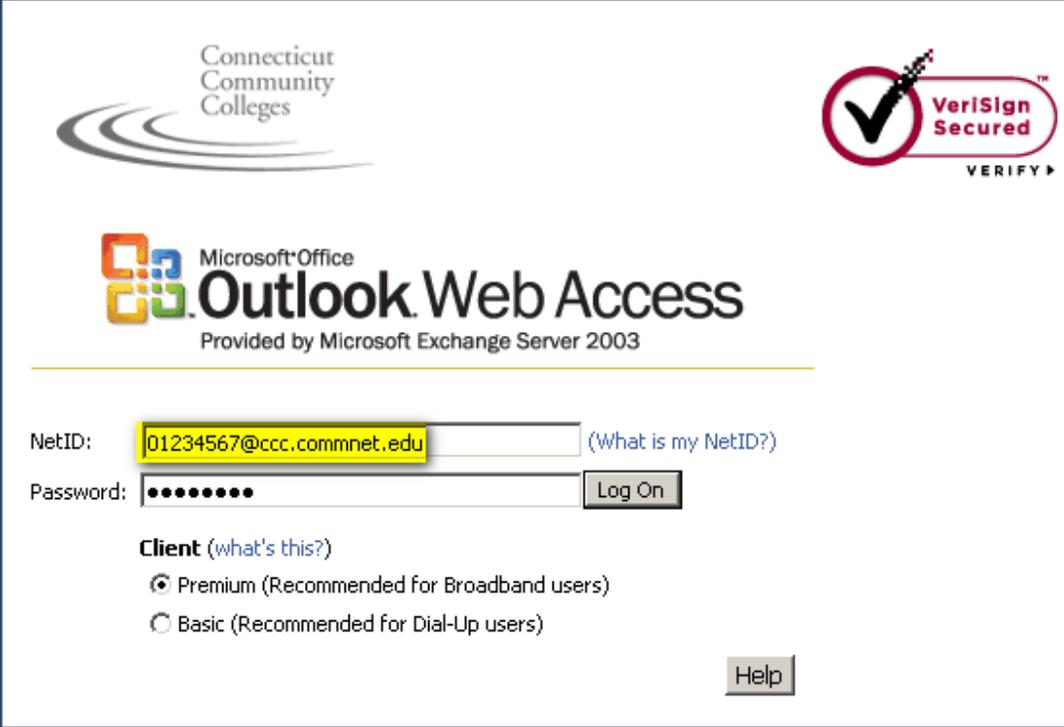
A. Yes, this is correct. For logging into NetID you will drop the @ symbol before your BANNER ID. Banner Web for Faculty still uses the @ symbol before your BANNER ID.

Q. For those of us who have access to INB (Internet Native Banner), which currently uses another username (e.g. *g_jtimey*), will that also change?

A. The logon to INB will **not** change.

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- Q.** It sounds like the new username will apply to logging on to Outlook Web Access from home also - correct?
- A.** Yes, your NetID is now your BannerID followed by the college domain identifier. Remember your email address will not change.

A. Yes, the logon won't change as the images below illustrate.
