

- 1. Students not presenting two years of a high school foreign language must take 12 credit hours of one language. Students with two years of a high school foreign language may satisfy the 12 hour requirement by taking 6 additional hours of the same language at the intermediate level and 6 hours in open electives.
- 2. Math elective is dependent upon program chosen and major emphasis. Math majors should follow the calculus sequence: MA130,MA201,MA202,MA203, MA204.
- 3. Only four-credit science courses may be used to meet this requirement. Math 115 is required prior to Chemistry 121 or CH122.
- 4. Should be selected from CS111, CS113, or CS115.
